Since 1991, Faustino Torrico is a professor of infectious diseases and parasitic diseases at the Faculty of Medicine of the Universidad Mayor de San Simón, Cochabamba, Bolivia. At the university, Professor Torrico is also Coordinator and Professor of Tropical Medicine postgraduate course in Tropical Medicine. Between 2004 and 2007, Torrico was responsible for the diagnosis and treatment of National Control Programme of Chagas disease in Bolivia, and is currently technical adviser of the same program and project coordinator Catalan, the Platform for Adult attention Chagas. Torrico has published numerous papers, mainly from research done in the field of infectious diseases prevalent in Bolivia (Chagas disease, tuberculosis, leishmaniasis and HIV). The focus of his research is clinical medicine, epidemiology and diagnosis, especially in congenital Chagas disease.
