Dr José L Bartha, M.D. Ph.D. was graduated at the University of Malaga. He moved and got his Ph.D. degree at the University of Seville, where he also got his specialization in Obstetrics and Gynecology. After developing his first research lines in the field of High Risk Pregnancy in Cadiz, he moved to the U.K., where he worked as a Consultant Senior Lecturer in Maternal and Fetal Medicine at the University of Bristol / St Michael's Hospital. After two years he came back to Spain as Professor in Obstetrics and Gynecology at the university of Cadiz, and recently he moved to his current post in Madrid. He has published more than 120 papers, more than a half of them in high quality international journals. He also has published many chapters of books and has participated in many international and national congresses as invited speaker. He is an active member of the Spanish Society of Obstetrics and Gynecology (SEGO) and its Section of Perinatal Medicine. Currently he is the coordinator of the Spanish Group of Diabetes in Pregnancy (GEDE). His main research areas are Diabetes and Obesity in Pregnancy, Inflammation in Pregnancy and Fetal Medicine.
